On Sunday, September 28, 2008, at 3 o'clock pm, the Schiller Institute will sponsor a recital concert at the Dante Alighieri Society in Cambridge, MA, culminating a 10-day master class held by the Italian soprano, **Antonella Banaudi**. The concert will feature Italian arias and art songs sung by the young master-class participants and Bach's motet, *Jesu, meine Freude*, and Verdi's *Va Pensiero*, sung by the Schiller Institute Chorus, directed by John Sigerson.

The concert will be performed at the natural scientific tuning of C=256 and will include a presentation on the Schiller Institute's campaign to return to the natural tuning pitch of A=432 Hz, instead of the unnaturally high tuning of A = 440 Hz and even higher, which have prevailed since the middle of the last century, and which have prevented young voices from reaching their fullest potential.
